- referee details (x1)

REGISTERED SCIENTIST

- up-to-date CV
- RSci Competence Report
- copies of highest qualifications
- referee details (x1)
- post nominals: **RSci**



CHARTERED SCIENTIST

- up-to-date CV
- CSci Competence Report
- copies of highest qualifications
- referee details (x1)
- post nominals: **CSci**



The Competence Report (not meant to intimidate you – it's there to help you shine)*:

The competence report for the Professional Registration level you are applying for should contain examples of your work experience.

Consult the guidance notes to help you understand what the assessors will be looking for when reading your answers.

If you are stuck for examples, ask your line manager or mentor (and consult your CPD record) to help jog your memory of previous projects.

Take ownership of the examples you mention: Use I not We : assessors are looking for your contribution in the examples you describe.

When completing the report, be aware of listing “turn of events” in the example you choose. Highlight how your skills and your knowledge helped you.
