



#### Mission





 To bring together national sensory science organizations from Europe under a single organization in order to:



- Facilitate the growth of Sensory Science
- Promote co-operation, shared goals, integration of activities, and knowledge and information exchange amongst national sensory science organisations in Europe
- Establish, maintain and enhance the professional status of sensory scientists
- Develop and disseminate research, innovation and education in sensory science

#### Aims




- Promote collaborative discussion and research
- Promote collaborative educational activities, such as Master and PhD courses
- Provide practical information for sensory practitioners
- Provide opportunities for networking, through formal and informal events, membership lists, etc.
- Encourage novice sensory scientists to enter the profession



#### Aims cont...



- Promote continuing professional development through a variety of means, such as mentoring, travel awards, training courses, workshops, conferences, etc.
- Provide career advice
- Promote the professional conduct by upholding ethical,
   legal and appropriate laboratory practices
- Author and/or edit published material on sensory science, including manuals, standards, newsletters, websites and journals
- Link with sensory science organisations outside Europe





### Examples of E3S activities





- Organise a bi-annual European sensory conference,
- Organise ad-hoc conferences, seminars, workshops and training courses
- Support/Adopt an international scientific journal
